

Game Rules

- 2 – 18 minute halves with a running clock until the last minute of each half.
 - 2 minute halftime
- Timeouts: 3 per game...1 additional for overtime.
- 35 points will be the max score difference
- Fouls -3rd – 8th grades, each player will be given 5 personal fouls. – Bonus applied (1 for 2)
- Shooting foul – if made, basket will count and 1 additional point will be awarded
- Foul shots will be 1 for 2 or 3 (entire game)
- Overtime - 1st team to score

League Rules

- A Player must have played in a pool play game in order to play in the tournament with a team.
- Coaches are expected to communicate Covid Guidelines to players and parents.
- Teams must enter/exit the gym through the proper doors before and after games.
- All participants (coaches, players and fans) need to have a mask for admission.
- Fans should use the QR reader before entering (1-2 fans per player).

3rd grade

Ball size – 27.5 (youth)

Rim height – 9 ft

Officiated by the high school players

4th grade

Ball size – 28.5 (Women's size basketball)

Regular Rules will be followed -

Rim height – 10 feet - due to gym spacing.

5th Grade - 6th Grade

Ball size – 28.5

(Women's size basketball) - (6th can play 29.5 ball if both coaches agree, but 28.5 will be default)

Ball size – 29.5 (regulation)
